The meeting in was called to order by President Ellen Deane. Prior meeting minutes were read, amended and approved.



Preparation for the June 8, 2021 Democratic Party Primary, including reviewing availability of all voting sites, ADA preparedness, and emergency alternate polling locations were discussed. List of Officers of Election for each precinct was reviewed and final roster will be completed in May.


The Board came out of closed session at 11:30 am and there being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 11:45 am.
